Red Ribbon Theme Day	What to Wear
<b>Wednesday, October 23:</b> "Show Good Character by Staying Away from Drugs" Day	Students dress up as their favorite book, movie, or TV show character.
<b>Thursday, October 24:</b> "Have Spirit to Not Do Drugs!" Day	Students wear their St. Emily Spirit Wear (Grades PreK-5). Each class also will participate in signing their own poster. Grades 6th, 7th, and 8th wear their Spirit Wear on Monday, November 4th. (Because of 10/24 field trip)
<b>Friday October 25:</b> "Encourage Others to Stay Drug Free" Day	Each student bring a plain, light colored, t-shirt to school. Students will write encouraging words on it. After, the shirt will be worn over the school uniform.
<b>Monday, October 28:</b> "Whatever Your Role is, Don't Do Drugs" Day	Students dress up like teachers, and teachers dress like students.
<b>Tuesday, October 29:</b> "Search for Treasure, Not Drugs" Day	A treasure hunt around the school will take place for each class. Students may also wear a pirate accessories (hats, eye patches, etc.)
<b>Wednesday, October 30:</b> "No Matter What Decade, Drugs are Never Cool" Day	Students dress like their favorite decade.
<b>Thursday, October 31 (Halloween):</b> "Scare Away Drugs" Day	Students wear their costumes to "hide" who they are so drugs don't find them. <b>No blood, scary masks, or weapons are allowed. (This also serves as the End-of-the-month Dress Down Day.)</b>
